In December, we implemented our Archiving solution. It works like this:

1. Data from closed files will be kept in econveyance indefinitely
2. Closed files can be reopened as needed by contacting the Help Desk
3. Close multiple files at one time
4. Option to download all documents to your local system or to simply delete all documents, upon closing the file
5. A Client History Report is available to allow users to quickly obtain a report on all files done in econveyance, both open and closed, for a particular client
6. A Closed File Report is available to allow users to generate a report on files that are closed

### EFS

Some of you may not be aware of the cost associated with using your digital signature on EFS documents. The Law Society of British Columbia announced that starting August 15, 2004, there would be a fee for the use of Juricert digital signatures on documents filed through the Land Title Office's Electronic Filing System. The details are as follows:

*"A fee of \$2.50 plus GST for each digital signature is charged to the BC OnLine account of the party submitting a Form C Charge and Release, Form A Transfer, Form B Mortgage, Claim of Lien and Form 17s. There are no digital signature charges for the PTT form or the Declarations. Each transaction will appear on the submitting party's BC OnLine billing statement similar to current services."*

### CONVEYANCING TIPS

If you are filing a Form A Transfer immediately following a transmission, it is not necessary to include the filing number of the transmission in Section 4 Transferor (s) of the Form A. The important part is how it is worded in the signature box ie. Joe Smith, Executor of the estate of Mary Smith.
